



NEEDS LIST

Clothes:

- All clothes and shoes for children of all ages;
- Underwear for girls and boys from 3 - 18 years;
- Sleepwear, pyjamas, tracksuit pants and T-shirts, both long and short sleeves, for 7– 18 years;
- Socks for girls and boys;
- Cropped pants and shorts for boys and girls;
- Boxers shorts for boys, and
- Summer clothes of all sizes.

(Please note that clothes not suitable for children will be sold for funds.)

Bedding:

- Sheets;
- Pillowcases;
- Blankets;
- Pillows;
- Curtains;
- Shower curtains;
