- ☺ Please see attached the list of our children's as well as our houses' biggest wishes (that are not necessarily material items) as well as what gifts they would like to receive for Christmas.
- ☺ Should you wish to buy a gift, please confirm with us by e-mail [goods@durbanvillekinderhuis.co.za](mailto:goods@durbanvillekinderhuis.co.za) or by fax (021 975 1613) to which child/house you would like to give, as we would like to ensure that each child receives a gift.
- ☺ You are welcome to wrap the gift. Please include the child's name and house number on the outside. Please bring it to our attention if cash is included in a parcel for safe-keeping. Please take care not to put soap together with sweets or any food.
- ☺ If you would like to drop off any donations to the children's home, please do so between 07:00 – 18:00 daily. Please ensure that you leave your details at reception after dropping off a donation. Due to limited staff available, it is difficult for us to collect the donations.
- ☺ The personal handing over of gifts to the children is unfortunately not possible due to logistical rules. Presents will be handed over to the children on the 6<sup>th</sup> of December and at the Children's home Christmas functions during Dec/Jan summer holiday.
- ☺ Gifts can be brought to the Children's Home from the **8<sup>th</sup> of November**.

- ☺ Only pre-selected weekend and holiday friends may take out individual children during the holidays. The selection process begins with an orientation and evaluation programme for ± 3 - 6 months. Unfortunately no children can be placed with you for the holidays unless you have completed this programme.
